Qualifications:

Will train; **Experience in Water Operations preferred.**

Valid Driver's License

Education: High School Diploma/GED required.

Drug screening. Must pass test prior to hiring.

Must be at least 21 years of age.

Must possess both organizational and communication skills in dealing with the public.

Must be able to follow instruction.

Must have or be able to obtain class C water license from the Oklahoma Department of Environmental Quality as soon as possible; **Class C in hand preferred.**

Must be willing to work on an "on-call" status for nights, weekends and emergencies.

Physical Demands Required:

Must be able to operate a motor vehicle

Must be able to lift and or move at least 50 lbs.

Work in extreme conditions; cold, heat, rain, ice & mud.

Use hand shovel, Skill saw, power equipment, portable generator, heat gun, weed eater, mower as necessary.

Essential Duties & Responsibilities :

To include but not limited to repair and maintenance in all areas of the distribution system, physically reading/ documenting, repairing of water meters, valves, waterlines, standpipes.

Generators: Check at least quarterly or more often as necessary, clean, change oil and maintain; keep propane tanks that run generators full.

Complete work orders as given and document daily. Keep log of daily activities, maintenance completed, etc...

Including but not limited to maintenance of all equipment including vehicles, documentation of maintenance of all equipment including & operating backhoe, Mini X, loading and unloading equipment on trailers.

Check and maintain ODEQ chlorine residual standard and document twice a day.

Properly take water samples, clean sample sites that have been approved by ODEQ;

Monthly and as directed.

Attend all monthly water meetings or more often as required.

Maintain chlorination and pump equipment at well(s) site and booster stations and other duties as assigned.

To use Diamond maps GPS to document & update location of water lines, valves, etc...

Read and understand a paper map/know directions of North, South East & West.

Use SCADA telemetry to monitor water towers, checked daily, several times a day as necessary.

Mow, weeds eat as needed or directed.

Work independently as needed and complete task in a timely manner.

After completing probationary period benefits include: employer -paid health, dental and vision insurance (employee only), retirement account, vacation, holiday and sick leave.
